### This month we will be discussing the concept of rendering all that we have unto God. We, of course, consider rendering our earthly goods: we pledge our tithes and have special offerings throughout the year, we donate food or clothing to those in need, we find ways to simplify our lives. And these are all wonderful things. But we are meant to give everything to God; truly we are

giving everything back to God since it has all come from God in the first place.

**Render Unto God** 

In this month's series, we will be examining the often-non-tangible things that we ought to render unto God through the lens of the psalms. There are four main types of psalms: Praise, Lament, Thanksgiving, and Wisdom. Praise and Thanksgiving are likely the simplest, though not in all cases. We have set aside a day this month to consider and celebrate everything that we have to be thankful for; why not make this an everyday thing? The same can be said for praise-in what ways are you praising God today?

The other two types-wisdom and lament-present a greater challenge but for different reasons. The question that pops into my mind is how do I render wisdom unto God? Our God who is omniscient and omnipotent; whose wisdom exceeds anything that we can fathom? How is it possible? The answer rings out: by sharing our wisdom with others. By sharing our gifts, talents, and experiences to witness to others of the goodness of God.

Finally, we come to the psalms of lament. We often offer our concerns to God, but we rarely lament in the truest form. When you read through the psalms, you find questioning and crying and demanding; you find lament. We often prevent ourselves from truly lamenting for fear of offending God or to spare others our pain, but I'm here to tell you that God can take whatever you may offer and the people who have been put in your life to support you want to help you through your periods of pain. Allow yourselves to lament, my friends. God will listen just
